Tonier "Neen" Cain lived on the streets for twenty nightmarish years, years filled with hunger, brutality and a lifestyle when described seems unconscionable. In 2004 when Tonier was incarcerated and pregnant, someone finally took the time to ask: "what happened to you" instead of "what's wrong with you." It is at that moment she began her journey to become a survivor and for the first



time in her life began to live with more hope than fear. As Ms. Cain shares her story, audience members find themselves challenging their professional and personal beliefs. Her experience illustrates the consequences that untreated trauma has on individuals and society at-large, including mental health problems, addiction, homelessness and incarceration.
